LEPC Emergency Plan Update

HMEP Grant

The Emergency Response Plan is due to the State Fire Marshal's Office on Sept. 30, along with all grant documentation.

The committee reviewed the draft of the Emergency Response Plan for LEPC. The following suggested edits were made:

Page 18, 6th paragraph – correct sentence “of Milton-Freewater and the CTUIR are answered by the Umatilla (delete “at”)

Page 19, 6th paragraph – Replace “community emergency coordinator” with “County Emergency Manager”

Page 24, last paragraph, 1st sentence – sentence should read “...incident threat, current AND FORECASTED weather”

Page 31, Federal Agencies – Add NOAA, National Guard, Coast Guard, National Forest Service, Oregon Dept. of Forestry, others as needed.

Page 35, 1st sentence - Replace “community emergency coordinator” with “County Emergency Manager”

Page 36 – Change MSDS to MDS

Page 47-50 – Add contact info to all organizations, include NOAA, ODF (Pendleton Phone: 541-276-3491), USFS, UPRR

Page 52 – Include NOAA and Public Radio for EAS messages. Include link to Umatilla County’s webpage with Natural Hazardous Mitigation Plan and Emergency Operations Plan?

Page 60 – “Appendix” - the AP is crossed out

Page 62 – Is this the most recent Hazmat teams map?
