OSFM INTERPRETATION FORM INSTRUCTIONS

- NOTE:** Unless otherwise stated, all interpretations will be based on the fire and life safety regulations which are currently adopted and in effect as promulgated by the Oregon State Fire Marshal.

- PETITIONER INFORMATION:** Complete the required information. If any information is not available, please indicate with an “N/A”. If other information such as a pager or cellular phone number is available or if there is a time for contact that is more appropriate, please include this information.
- ISSUE/CONCERN:** State the issues or concerns which best describe the problem encountered or which specifies the discrepancy or conflict in the code or regulation. Be as specific as possible. Attach any necessary information, drawings, diagrams, etc. which will help clarify the problem.
- REFERENCE:** Indicate which section of code, law, administrative rule, standard or policy that applies to this issue or concern. Also indicate which edition that is being referred to as well as the adoption date. If the issue or concern is related to a local code adoption, please provide the specific language from that document for the committee’s reference.
- BACKGROUND:** Provide why this issue is a problem, what has led up to this becoming an issue, how current interpretations do not apply or do not adequately address the concern, or any other information which will assist the committee with its deliberations. **Special Note:** It is not the committee’s responsibility to decide if a fire authority’s decision (on how the code applies to a given situation) is “correct” or compare if it is the same as the state fire marshal’s application. The committee’s responsibility is to interpret regulations which are unclear or where there is discretion on the part of the fire authority.
- PROPOSED RESOLUTION:** If you have a recommendation for the committee, propose how you would resolve this issue or correct this problem. Provide any needed supplemental information to clarify your position.
