



Rogue Valley YCF aids youngster in need

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Rogue Valley YCF staff and youth have been rallying since late 2013 to aid a Grants Pass girl with a rare medical disorder. Lilliana “Lilly” Maupin, 2, suffers from hydrocephalus, which causes the brain to accumulate excess fluid. Treating the condition requires costly medical treatments. Rogue Valley adopted Lilly as a holiday charitable project through Sparrow Clubs USA, a Pacific Northwest non-profit that supports medically challenged youth in need. Through various fundraisers, staff and youth donated a total of about \$2,300 to Lilly’s family, who visited the facility March 19 to receive flowers, toys and a final check.
