When does the Non-Prescription Drug Outlet Registration Expire?

Non-Prescription Drug Outlet Registrations expire January 31st annually. However, we must receive your renewal payment in the amount of \$50.00 by the postmark deadline of December 31st. We will mail your outlet a renewal notice in November.



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What is a Non Prescription Drug Outlet?

A Non-Prescription Drug Outlet is any outlet that sells over-the-counter non prescription medication to the public. This includes stores, gas stations, hotels, gift shops, taverns and other outlets offering over-the-counter medications for sale.

What is an Over-the Counter Medication?

According to the FDA over-the-counter drugs are:

- Drugs that do not require a prescription.
- Regulated by the FDA.
- Purchased off the shelf in stores.

Is a Registration Required to Sell Non Prescription Drugs?

Yes, Oregon Law requires any Outlet that sells medications to the public to be registered with the Oregon Board of Pharmacy. Outlets that only sell over-the-counter medications to the public are required to register as a Class A Non Prescription Drug Outlet.

This Registration allows an outlet to sell seven or more types of over-the-counter medications.

Who can a Non Prescription Drug Outlet Purchase Over-the-Counter Medications from?

Non-Prescription Drug Outlets may only purchase over-the-counter medications from Wholesalers that are registered with the Oregon Board of Pharmacy. You may verify that a Wholesaler has an active license with the Board by going to our website.



Can I Sell Prescription Drugs with this Registration?

No, you may not sell prescription drugs with a Non Prescription Drug Outlet Registration. Only registered pharmacies with licensed pharmacists may sell prescription drugs.

What Items Can I Sell with a Non Prescription Drug Outlet Registration?

You may sell over-the-counter FDA approved medications that do not require a prescription. Here are a few examples of the over-the-counter medications you can sell.

Aspirin	Tylenol
Ibuprofen	Pepto Bismol
Nyquil	Theraflu
Roloids	Nasal Spray

How do I Register a Non-Prescription Drug Outlet?
