Need for the Temporary Rule(s):

The Board's 2013-15 Legislatively Adopted Budget, which goes into effect July 1, 2013 includes implementing temporary fee reductions pursuant to ORS 291.055(3). In addition to the Pharmacist fee that was reduced in April, the following fees will be reduced: Reciprocity, County Health Clinics, Family Planning Clinics, Hospital Drug Rooms, Correctional Facilities, Prophylactic/Contraceptive Outlets, Retail and Institutional Drug Outlets, Home Dialysis Drug Outlets and all Controlled Substance registration fees.
