Need for the Temporary Rule(s):

Current rules regarding supervision that pharmacists must give to pharmacy technicians prevent pharmacies from using audiovisual technology to exercise required supervision. The Board believes that there are opportunities for accomplishing certain pharmacy functions using audio-visual technology that can enhance patient safety and pharmacy efficiency. This rule change creates a procedure for a pharmacy to apply to introduce such a system.

Justification of Temporary Rule(s):

The Board finds that pursuing permanent rulemaking procedures will delay the implementation of these rules and cause serious prejudice to the public interest in that there are pharmacies that have already invested in appropriate technology that has the potential to enhance patient safety and pharmacy efficiency, but which cannot be authorized under current rules.
