
Transparency Oregon Advisory Commission

Public Meeting Manager Version 2.0 Attributes

- Public Meeting Manager Version 2.0 is more portable, mobile, and accessible. From an iPhone or mobile device using a *web browser*:
 - Those who are approved to enter public meetings can do so on the go;
 - Users and the General Public can also view meeting information on the go (date, time, location, contact info, etc.);
- The application was redesigned and delivered at no cost, as originally mandated by Legislation, through the E-Government Program;
- The design benefited from usability testing with agency members;
- Developers coded the application with reusability in mind, which will shorten development time for future projects with similar needs.

- New URL to access the application: now on the Egov platform
- Real time publishing
- Meetings can have “multiple” owners
- Some changes to the layout/content of the “data entry form”

What's New in Version 2.0?

Changes to the Data Entry Form:

HB 2370/HB 3400

Requires DAS to post a link on the transparency website to public meeting minutes/summaries if they are posted on an agency website

There is now a new data field in the Public Meeting Manager for an agency to enter the website link (URL) to where their public meeting minutes and summaries are posted.

What is a Public Meeting?

The 2011 Oregon Legislature passed [House Bill 2788](#). [HB 2788](#) requires State Agencies, Boards, Commissions, and Education Service Districts (ESDs) to "...post on the Oregon Transparency website notices of public meetings required to be provided by the state agency under [ORS 192.640](#)."

As State Agencies, Boards, Commissions, and Education Service Districts (ESDs) determine which meeting notices to post on this site they will be asking themselves:

Is it a "public meeting"?

- Does the meeting involve a government entity of *any* type - local, regional or otherwise? (This entity is known as a "public body.")
- Do the people attending the meeting have authority to make decisions or recommendations to the public body? (This group is known as a "governing body.")
- Is a quorum required for the governing body to meet in order to make a decision?
- Is the governing body planning to make a decision or deliberate toward a decision of *any type* at the meeting?

If the answer to **all** questions is "Yes", the meeting is a "public meeting" and falls under the requirements of [HB2788](#). For additional detail, refer to [ORS 192.610 to 192.690](#).
